Eval Comments: “The behaviors described today reflect the dog’s responses in an Animal Care Center environment and during assessment. A dog's behavior in an Animal Care Center may differ significantly from how they behave in a home. Stress, confinement, and unfamiliar surroundings can cause dogs to act out—or suppress behaviors that may emerge later. A dog's behavior may change based on surroundings, training, medical, socialization, and life experiences.”

Easy to leash and easy walk to the yard. Once at the gate, he avoided interaction and gave displacement behaviors (sniffing the ground, etc). In the yard he avoided interaction, tolerant of dogs attempting to play and seek engagement. Gave an appropriate correction when a dog lingered in his face (air snap from a growl and showing teeth).
