Monitor for appetite, behavior and worsening condition and contact veterinarian if this occurs. Feed canned food to entice appetite, if necessary.

If this patient continues to show signs after 7 days, bring to veterinarian for refill of medication. The infection may take up to 3 weeks to clear.

OK TO GO OUT ON TRUST- URI- RETURN 1 WEEK AFTER MEDICATION IS DONE AND SIGNS HAVE DISSIPATED.
