Eval Comments: “The behaviors described today reflect the dog’s responses in an Animal Care Center environment and during assessment. A dog's behavior in an Animal Care Center may differ significantly from how they behave in a home. Stress, confinement, and unfamiliar surroundings can cause dogs to act out—or suppress behaviors that may emerge later. A dog's behavior may change based on surroundings, training, medical, socialization, and life experiences.”

Alarm barking on approach, I entered the kennel without incident and knelt down, she slowly approached and turned her head up and offered her side to me. I went slow, able to pet/touch without incident. She was flinchy at times, slow to warm up and approach for more engagement. Eventually she did crawl on my lap. I was able to pick up and perform handling "exam" without incident.
