Eval Comments: “The behaviors described today reflect the dog’s responses in an Animal Care Center environment and during assessment. A dog's behavior in an Animal Care Center may differ significantly from how they behave in a home. Stress, confinement, and unfamiliar surroundings can cause dogs to act out or suppress behaviors that may emerge later. A dog's behavior may change based on surroundings, training, medical, socialization, and life experiences.”

Freckles was lying down at the back of the kennel with a quiet demeanor, but stood up to greet the runner after some coaxing. His body was neutral, and his eyes were soft. He was easy to leash and remove from the kennel, pulled slightly on leash while bypassing the other kennels, and was easy to collar while soliciting petting. He was muzzled prior to entering the yard due to his reported history of aggression toward other dogs. He entered the yard, and exchanged appropriate greetings with the other dogs. He roamed the yard with neutral demeanor. He barked and snapped when one of the dogs bumped into him. He stayed near the handlers after that, using them as shields from the other dogs. He solicited petting from the handlers. He would panic and jump on the table when the dogs approached him, and had to be picked up and placed back on the ground each time. Freckles is highly defensive with the other dogs, has a medium energy level, and does not have a playstyle at this time.
