Medical observation:

Unable to examine due to behavior

unable to handle, very reactive to injection. Cat in crouched position, did not observe cat walking or in upright position. Unable to physically check gender

Routine vaccination: Nobivac FRCP+ RS SQ (booster in 2-4 weeks)+anti -parasitic Revolution .4 ml

Grooming level:2

cat has generalized alopecia with scabs unable to do skin scraping

Clavamox .8 ml bid for 7 days

Chlorpheniramine 4 mg 1/2 tab sid for 7 days

A scrotal incision was made over the left testicle and the testicle was exteriorized . The subcutaneous tissue was removed. The cord, cremaster, and vessels were then tied on themselves and the testicle removed distal to the knot. This was repeated for the right testicle.
