Eval Comments: “The behaviors described today reflect the dog’s responses in an Animal Care Center environment and during assessment. A dog's behavior in an Animal Care Center may differ significantly from how they behave in a home. Stress, confinement, and unfamiliar surroundings can cause dogs to act out—or suppress behaviors that may emerge later. A dog's behavior may change based on surroundings, training, medical, socialization, and life experiences.”

On approach she was sitting on the Kuranda bed while the other dogs were outside. I closed her in and entered the kennel. Knelt down and she started to tremble, whale eyed and did not move away. I slowly placed my hand on the Kuranda bed and she took a snap (did not make contact), I then presented my leash and initially she dodged it but I was able to get my leash on her. Exited without issue, took her to walk along the back end of the care center. Initially she was pacing, displaying anxious behavior (looking around, flinchy to touch). I was able to touch her without incident the longer we were away from the kennels. Able to pick her up and carry her to the photo room. Placed an ID band and set her down, she then sought engagement after she went to the bathroom. Some zoomies, lightly mouthy play. Able to pet/ouch and perform handling "exam" without incident. Carried her back to the kennel.
