Eval Comments: “The behaviors described today reflect the dog’s responses in an Animal Care Center environment and during assessment. A dog's behavior in an Animal Care Center may differ significantly from how they behave in a home. Stress, confinement, and unfamiliar surroundings can cause dogs to act out or suppress behaviors that may emerge later. A dog's behavior may change based on surroundings, training, medical, socialization, and life experiences.”

Georgie A5773447 greeted the runner with a wiggly body, soft eyes, a neutral tail wag and a closed mouth. He was easy to remove, and he ran through the kennel with a moderate pull-on leash, he ran towards the dogs and greeted them excitedly. In the catch pen when he was introduced to the dogs his body was wiggly, his eyes were soft, and his tail wagged neutrally. He was easy to collar and leash. He bolted inside the yard and greeted the dogs with a relaxed body, soft eyes, and a neutral tail wag. He play vowed and ran loosely with the dogs. He engaged in play. He attempted to mount the dogs and had to be corrected a few times. He solicited affection from the handler but would become mouthy at times (all in play). He played with the dogs the entire time he was out in the yard with them, his body remained relaxed, his eyes were soft, his tail wagged neutrally, and his mouth was open with a soft pant. Overall, he was social with the dogs and would benefit best in a push/pull yard. Behaviorally ok for public adoption, large dogs ok.
