She was submissive, she let the dogs sniff and hover around her. When her leash got stuck under the chair, she yelped. Her body remained relaxed, her eyes were soft, and her tail was low with a soft wag. Overall, Brandy was social with the dogs and would benefit best in a gentle/dainty yard.
