Eval Comments: “The behaviors described today reflect the dog’s responses in an Animal Care Center environment and during assessment. A dog's behavior in an Animal Care Center may differ significantly from how they behave in a home. Stress, confinement, and unfamiliar surroundings can cause dogs to act out or suppress behaviors that may emerge later. A dog's behavior may change based on surroundings, training, medical, socialization, and life experiences.”

Miley greeted the runner with a relaxed body, dilated pupils, and a wiggly rear end. She was easy to leash and remove from the kennel, pulled lightly on leash while bypassing the other kennels, and was easy to collar. In the catch pen, her body was neutral, her eyes were soft, and her tail was neutral with a fast wag. She entered the yard, and immediately engaged in play with the other dogs. She played roughly, slamming into the other dogs with puppy exuberance. She jumped o the handler’s roughly, and solicited petting. Miley is social with the other dogs, has a high energy level, and prefers a rough/rowdy playstyle.
