Anesthesia

Pre-anesthetic: Acepromazine (2mg/ml) 0.6 cc IM, Butorphanol 10mg/ml: 0.7 cc IM,

Ampicillin 200mg/ml: 2.65 cc SQ

Induction: Ketamine (100 mg/ml) 1.2 cc IV, Midazolam (5 mg/ml) 1.2 cc IV

Intubation: Endotracheal tube size 10

Maintenance: Oxygen 2L Isoflurane 2%

Monitoring: Pulse oximeter

Supportive care: Thermoregulation pad/blanket

Rx: Azithromycin 250 mg PO SID x 7 days
 Doxycycline 250 mg PO SID X 10 days
